An extended summary describing work not previously published or presented must be submitted electronically as a PDF file to reach the Conference Secretariat no later than September 12, 2006

The extended summary must not exceed 4 pages on either A4 or 8.5 by 11 inch (letter size) format. Other than observing this page limit, there are no restrictions regarding the style of the first page, however do not include author's name, affiliation, mailing address, e-mail address, phone and fax numbers.

Please start your paper with

- choice of topic categories as listed above
- title of paper

The following information should be provided via a web submission system.

- author's name
- affiliation
- mailing address
- e-mail address, phone and fax numbers

Do not include your personal information in the extended summary.

The submitted summary will be used for paper selection, session assignment and program development. Therefore, the summary should clearly define the salient concepts and novel features of the work. Be sure to mention past or previous works to distinguish your originality from them.

Notification of acceptance: November 30, 2006

Authors will receive notification of acceptance by e-mail on or before November 30, 2006.

Deadline for Full Papers: January 31, 2007

Authors of accepted papers will be required to submit a manuscript not exceeding eight pages (A-4 size) in length for publication in the Conference Proceedings, by January 31, 2007. The registration application form and the required fee should also be sent by this date.

Authors whose summaries are accepted will receive detailed formatting instructions by e-mail. In the case of multiple authors, please indicate the author to whom the e-mail should be addressed.

Presentation

Accepted authors must present their papers either orally or as a poster. Several rooms will be prepared for both styles. Each speaker will have 20-30 minutes for oral presentation or a poster presentation. The Authors' Instructions will include details for presentation styles.

Language

The working language of the Conference will be English. All submissions and presentations must be in English.

Exhibition

The PCC-Nagoya Steering Committee plans to stage an exhibition of products and catalogs during the Conference. Those wishing to present Exhibition Booths should contact the Secretariat of PCC-Nagoya 2007.

Conference registration will start December 2006.

Social activities

Access to Nagoya

As the gateway to the Chubu Region, located in central Japan, Nagoya is the junction of land, marine and air traffic. Central Japan International Airport is connected to major cities around the world by direct flights, and Nagoya Station is the nucleus of a railway network comprising JR, private railways, and subway lines.

Tokyo is approximately 1 and a half hour and Osaka, Kyoto are within 1 hour by the Shinkansen bullet train Nozomi.

The Nagoya Congress Center is approximately 40 minutes by car or airport express from the airport, and only 10 minutes by subway from downtown Nagoya.
