1. Copyrights (all of the rights stipulated in the provisions from Article 21 to Article 28 in the Japanese Copyright Law) are hereby transferred to the IEEJ.
2. Authors agree that IEEJ grants IEEE an irrevocable, worldwide, non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty free license to use, distribute, reproduce, and sell IPEC-Himeji 2022 publication in all media whether now known or hereinafter created.
3. Authors should take full cautions in quoting articles from other works to avoid any infringement of copyrights.
4. Even if the copyrights have been transferred to the IEEJ, the authors reserve the following rights:
 - i. All proprietary rights other than copyright, such as patent rights
 - ii. Re-use of part of the paper for their curriculum vitae
